



Macro Internship Opportunities

What does Maria Droste's Macro Internship track offer?

A macro-level focused internship experience that will provide you with opportunities to become familiar with the overall operation of a nonprofit community counseling organization. Interns will learn various facets of nonprofit management including program development, assessment and evaluation, and process improvement. This is an in-person internship with limited opportunities for remote work. Supervision will be provided by an LCSW 2 hours/month to meet MSW requirements

Are there different types of Macro internships?

While our Macro internship positions will focus on different tasks and goals and will work with different supervisors, there are no different "types" of Macro internship.

Will I be working with clients?

No, you will not interface with individual clients. Instead, the agency will be your primary point of intervention. This internship is focused on development of macro-level skills.

What core competencies will I build?

Although internship is aimed at supporting the development of all 10 core competencies, macro interns will especially improve upon competencies 1, 3 through 7, & 9. Read more about social work core competencies and what each entails [here](#).

What is the time commitment?

Our macro internship begins in September and ends in May of each year. Interns will dedicate 13-16 hours per week to internships.
